The Pakistan-Born Community in Victoria — 2016 Census (ranked 15)



Demographic characteristics

At the 2016 Census, there were 21,125 Pakistan-born persons in Victoria (34.1% of Australia's total), ranked 15th among the overseas-born communities in Victoria. The Pakistan-born increased by 129.9% (11,938) from 9,187 persons in 2011. They are distributed throughout Metropolitan Melbourne, with significant concentrations in the LGAs of Moreland (14.5%), Casey (11.3%), Greater Dandenong (10.0%), Hume (9.8%) and Wyndham (9.8%).

The Pakistan-born reflected a young to adult age profile: 33.5% were aged 25 years and under; 54.8% were aged 26-44 years; 9.8% were aged 45-64; and 1.9% were aged 65 years and over. The median age was 29 years, compared to 37 years for total Victoria. The gender ratio was 172 males to 100 females, compared to 96 males to 100 females for total Victoria.

There were 20,898 persons identified with Pakistani ancestry. Most of them were born in Pakistan (69.1%) and Australia (23.1%). Just 6.6% of the Pakistan-born persons in Victoria had arrived in Australia prior to 1996; 5.0% arrived in 1996-2000; 8.5% arrived in 2001-2005; 21.6% arrived in 2006-2010; and 55.7% arrived in 2011-2016.

Over two-thirds (69.1%) speak Urdu at home; 8.5% speak Pashto; 6.3% speak Hazaraghi; 2.8% speak Dari; and 1.8% speak Sindhi. Most (89.6%) of the Pakistani-born are Muslim and 2.3% are Catholic; 2.1% have no religion. Over one-third (37.0%) of the Pakistan-born have Australian citizenship, compared to 58.3% for the total overseas-born in Victoria.







Economic characteristics

The education levels of the Pakistan-born are higher than for total Victoria: 20.7% have a postgraduate degree; and 26.1% have a bachelor degree, compared to 5.4% and 16.5% for Victoria. Only 4.4% of the Pakistan-born have a certificate and 31.1% have school education only, compared to 14.4% and 38.7% for Victoria.

The labour force participation rate of the Pakistan-born at 66.8% is higher than that for total Victoria at 60.5%. The unemployment rate for the Pakistan-born at 13.9% is also higher than for total Victoria at 6.6%.

The occupational patterns of the Pakistan-born are different from those for total Victoria. Less of the Pakistan-born (8.0%) are managers, 21.0% are professionals, 8.9% are technicians and trades workers and 9.0% are clerical and administrative workers, compared to 13.5%, 23.3%, 13.1% and 13.3% for Victoria. More of the Pakistan-born work as community & personal service workers (14.3%), machinery operators and drivers (15.3%) and labourers (12.8%) compared to 10.6%, 5.8% and 9.0% for Victoria.

The industry of employment patterns for the Pakistan-born are also different from total Victoria. Less of them are employed in construction (7.2%) and education and training (5.6%), compared to Victoria (8.3% and 8.6%). More of them are employed in transport, postal and warehousing (13.4%) and public administration and safety (7.3%), compared to 4.8% and 5.3% for Victoria.

The weekly personal income distribution pattern for the Pakistan-born is lower than total Victoria. More of them receive nil income (23.4%) than Victoria (9.7%). Less of them receive \$1,250-\$1,999 (9.1%) and \$2,000 or more (4.9%), compared to Victoria (13.6% and 7.5%).
