The Portugal-Born Community in Victoria — 2016 Census (ranked 72)



Demographic characteristics

At the 2016 Census, there were 2,731 Portugal-born persons in Victoria (17.3% of Australia's total), ranked 72nd among the overseas-born communities in Victoria. The Portugal-born increased by 3.1% (82) from 2,649 persons in 2011. They are distributed throughout Metropolitan Melbourne, with concentrations in the LGAs of Whittlesea (9.1%), Brimbank (8.9%), Casey (7.6%), Hume (6.8%) and Melton (6.6%); 8.9% live in regional Victoria.

The Portugal-born reflected a mature to ageing profile: 6.2% were aged 25 years and under; 32.8% were aged 26-44; 38.0% were aged 45-64; and 22.9% were aged 65 years and over. The median age was 52 years, compared to 37 years for total Victoria. The gender ratio was 103 males to 100 females, compared to 96 males to 100 females for total Victoria.

There were 12,230 persons identified with Portuguese ancestry. Most of them were born in Australia (35.3%), Portugal (20.3%), India (11.8%), Sri Lanka (6.3%) and Brazil (6.3%). Four-fifths (79.5%) of the Portugal-born in Victoria had arrived in Australia prior to 1996; 2.1% arrived in 1996-2000; 2.7% arrived in 2001-2005; 3.3% arrived in 2006-2010; and 9.6% arrived in 2011-2016.

Most (70.3%) of the Portugal-born speak Portuguese; 24.3% speak English only. Of those who speak a language other than English, 13.5% speak English not well/not at all. Three-quarters (76.1%) of the Portugal-born are Catholic; 13.6% have no religion. Three-quarters (77.7%) of the Portugal-born have Australian citizenship, compared to 58.3% for the total overseas-born population in Victoria.







Economic characteristics

The education levels of the Portugal-born are lower than for total Victoria: 4.2% have a postgraduate degree, 10.0% have a bachelor degree and 8.2% have an advanced diploma or diploma, compared to 5.4%, 16.5% and 9.2% for Victoria. One-half (48.3%) have school education only, compared to 38.7% for Victoria.

The labour force participation rate of the Portugal-born at 60.4% is similar to total Victoria at 60.5%. The unemployment rate for the Portugal-born at 5.2% is lower than for total Victoria at 6.6%.

The occupational patterns of the Portugal-born are different from those for total Victoria. Less of the Portugal-born work as managers (10.7%), professionals (17.1%) and clerical & administrative workers (10.1%), compared to 13.5%, 23.3% and 13.3% for Victoria. More of them are technicians and trades workers (21.1%) and labourers (16.5%), compared to 13.1% and 9.0% for Victoria.

The employment patterns of the Portugal-born are fairly similar to total Victoria, with some exceptions. Less of the Portugal-born are employed in agriculture, forestry, fishing & mining (0.4%), wholesale & retail trade (10.7%) and education & training (5.2%), compared to 2.6%, 13.4% and 8.6% for Victoria. More of the Portugal-born are employed in manufacturing (11.7%) and construction (19.6%), compared to 7.8% and 8.3% for Victoria.

The weekly personal income distribution pattern for the Portugal-born is fairly similar to total Victoria. More of them receive \$1-\$399 (24.4%), \$800-\$1,249 (8.0%) and \$1,250-\$1,999 (16.0%), compared to 20.1%, 16.7% and 13.6% for Victoria. Less of the Portugal-born receive \$400-\$799 (22.6%) compared to 23.1% for Victoria.
