The Seychelles-Born Community in Victoria — 2016 Census (ranked 97)



Demographic characteristics

At the 2016 Census, there were 949 Seychelles-born persons in Victoria (37.7% of Australia's total), ranked 97th among the overseas-born communities in Victoria. The Seychelles-born decreased by 4.5% (45) from 994 persons in 2011. They are distributed throughout Metropolitan Melbourne, with major concentrations in the LGAs of Casey (22.4%), Greater Dandenong (9.9%), Kingston (9.2%), Monash (7.4%) and Cardinia (4.4%).

The Seychelles-born reflected a mature to ageing profile: 4.9% were aged 25 years and under; 14.8% were aged 26-44; 40.5% were aged 45-64; and 39.7% were aged 65 years and over. The median age was 60 years, compared to 37 years for total Victoria. The gender ratio was 81 males to 100 females, compared to 96 males to 100 females for total Victoria.

There were 1,368 persons identified with Seychellois ancestry. Most of them were born in Australia (64.7%) and Seychelles (28.7%). Four-fifths (81.8%) of the Seychelles-born in Victoria had arrived in Australia prior to 1996; 2.3% arrived in 1996-2000; 4.3% arrived in 2001-2005; 5.6% arrived in 2006-2010; and 2.2% arrived in 2011-2016.

Most of the Seychelles-born speak Creole not further defined (31.1%), French (14.1%), French Creole not further defined (4.4%) and Seychelles Creole (2.7%); 44.0% speak English only. Most (85.4%) of the Seychelles-born are Catholic and 2.2% are Anglican; 4.4% have no religion. Most (90.8%) of the Seychelles-born have Australian citizenship, compared to 58.3% for overseas-born in Victoria.





Economic characteristics

The education levels of the Seychelles-born are lower than for total Victoria. Less of them (1.6%) have a postgraduate degree and 6.8% have a bachelor degree, compared to 5.4% and 16.5% for Victoria. More of them (44.2%) have school education only, compared 38.7% for Victoria.

The labour force participation rate of the Seychelles-born at 42.9% is lower than that of total Victoria at 60.5%. The unemployment rate for the Seychelles-born at 7.4% is higher than for total Victoria at 6.6%.from those for total Victoria.

The occupational patterns of the Seychelles-born are different from those for total Victoria. Less of them work as managers (10.4%), professionals (14.4%) and community & personal service workers (6.4%), compared to 13.5%, 23.3% and 10.6% for Victoria. More of the Seychelles-born are clerical & administrative workers (18.4%), machinery operators & drivers (12.3%) and labourers (16.8%), compared to 13.3%, 5.8% and 9.0% for Victoria.

The industry of employment patterns of the Seychelles-born are also different from total Victoria. More of them are employed in manufacturing (16.6%), transport, postal & warehousing (8.8%) and healthcare & social assistance (16.8%), compared to 7.8%, 4.8% and 12.5% for Victoria. Less of them are employed in accommodation & food services (2.7%), public administration & safety (2.4%) and education & training (5.1%), compared to 6.6%, 5.3% and 8.6% for Victoria.

The weekly personal income distribution pattern for the Seychelles-born is lower than total Victoria. More of them receive \$1-\$399 (28.4%) and \$400-\$799 (26.9%) than Victoria (20.1% and 23.1%). Less of them receive \$1,250-\$1,999 (10.9%) and \$2,000 or more (3.1%), compared to 13.6% and 7.5% for Victoria.
