# The United Arab Emirates-Born Community in Victoria – 2016 Census (71)



# **Demographic characteristics**

At the 2016 Census, there were 2,735 UAE-born persons in Victoria (33.2% of Australia's total), ranked 71<sup>st</sup> among the overseas-born communities in Victoria. The UAE-born increased by 58.2% (1,006) from 1,729 persons in 2011. They are distributed throughout Metropolitan Melbourne, with concentrations in the LGAs of Casey (11.6%), Wyndham (8.2%), Monash (7.5%), Hume (7.0%) and Whittlesea (6.1%).

The UAE-born reflected a very young to adult age profile: 67.3% were aged 25 years and under; 31.8% were aged 26-44; 0.8% were aged 45-64; and 0.2% were aged 65 years and over. The median age was 18 years, compared to 37 years for total Victoria. The gender ratio was 112 males to 100 females, compared to 96 males to 100 females for total Victoria.

There were 11.072 persons identified with Arab, not further defined ancestry. Most of them were born in Australia (29.6%), Iraq (18.8%), Saudi Arabia (12.5%), Lebanon (7.3%), Egypt (3.8%) and Syria (3.3%). Only 6.6% of the UAE-born in Victoria had arrived in Australia prior to 1996; 5.2% arrived in 1996-2000; 14.4% arrived in 2001-2005; 25.5% arrived in 2006-2010; and 45.0% arrived in 2011-2016.

The UAE-born speak Arabic (17.8%), Urdu (9.8%), Malayalam (8.9%), Sinhalese (3.6%) and Hindi (3.5%); 42.9% speak English only. Almost one-third (31.6%) of the UAE-born are Muslim; 24.4% are Catholic; 7.8% are Hindu; 3.8% are Oriental Orthodox; and 3.7% are Buddhist; 10.6% have no religion. Over half (55.5%) of UAE-born have Australian citizenship, compared to 58.3% for overseas-born in Victoria.





# **Economic characteristics**

The education levels of the UAE-born are higher than for total Victoria; 14.8% have a postgraduate degree; and 32.1% have a bachelor degree, compared to 5.4% and 16.5% for total Victoria.

The labour force participation rate of the UAE-born at 65.9% is slightly higher than that of total Victoria at 60.5%. The unemployment rate for the UAE-born at 13.2% is also higher than total Victoria at 6.6%.

The occupational patterns of the UAE-born are different from those for total Victoria. More of the UAE-born are professionals (32.7%) and sales workers (13.0%), compared to 23.3% and 9.7% for Victoria. Less of them are technicians and trades workers (8.5%), community & personal service workers (7.4%) and labourers (6.3%), compared to 13.1%, 10.6% and 9.0% for Victoria.

The industry of employment patterns of the UAE-born are also different from total Victoria. Less of them are employed in construction (3.3%), compared to 8.3% for Victoria. More of them are employed in accommodation & food services (8.9%), information, media & telecommunications (5.0%), finance & insurance (6.5%) and professional, scientific, technical & administrative (14.3%), compared to 6.6%, 1.9%, 3.9% and 11.4% for Victoria.

The weekly personal income distribution pattern for the UAE-born is fairly similar to that of total Victoria. A quarter (26.2%) of the UAE-born receive nil income compared to 9.7% for Victoria. Less of them (13.7%) receive \$400-\$799, compared to 23.1% for Victoria.
