Chart 1 Victoria: Top 30 Countries of Birth, 2016 Census




Chart 2 Victoria: Top 30 Overseas Countries of Birth by Increase in Numbers between 2011 and 2016 Census




Chart 3 Victoria: Top 30 Local Government Areas, Number of Overseas-Born, 2016 Census




Chart 4 Victoria: Top 30 Local Government Areas, Overseas-born as Percentage of LGA population, 2016 Census






Chart 6 Victoria: Top 30 Ancestries, Total Responses, 2016 Census




Chart 7 Victoria: Top 30 Languages other than English (LOTE) Spoken at Home, 2016 Census




Chart 8 Victoria: Top 30 Local Government Areas, Number of LOTE Speakers, 2016 Census




Chart 9 Victoria: Top 30 Local Government Areas, LOTE Speakers as Percentage of LGA Population, 2016 Census




Chart 10 Victoria: Top 30 Local Government Areas, Number of LOTE Speakers with Low English Proficiency, 2016 Census Areas




Chart 11 Victoria: Top 30 Religions, 2016 Census




Chart 12 Victoria: Religions by Increase in Numbers between 2011 and 2016 Census






Figure 1 Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Number of Persons Born Overseas by Local Government Areas: 2016 and 2011 Census







iii) Persons born overseas, percentage change between 2011 and 2016








Figure 2 Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Persons who Speak a Language other than English at Home by Local Government Areas: 2016 and 2011 Census






Figure 3 Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Overseas-born (Birthplace Regions) by Local Government Areas: 2016 Census






Figure 3 (continued) Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Overseas-born (Birthplace Regions) by Local Government Areas: 2016 Census






Figure 3 (continued) Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Overseas-born (Birthplace Regions) by Local Government Areas: 2016 Census






Figure 4 Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Top Twelve Overseas Countries of Birth by Local Government Areas: 2016 Census






Figure 4 (continued) Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Top Twelve Overseas Countries of Birth by Local Government Areas: 2016 Census






Figure 4 (continued) Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Top Twelve Overseas Countries of Birth by Local Government Areas: 2016 Census






Figure 4 (continued) Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Top Twelve Overseas Countries of Birth by Local Government Areas: 2016 Census






Figure 5 Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Top Twelve Ancestries, Total Responses, by **Local Government Areas: 2016 Census**






Figure 5 (continued) Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Top Twelve Ancestries, Total Responses, by Local Government Areas: 2016 Census






Figure 5 (continued) Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Top Twelve Ancestries, Total Responses, by Local Government Areas: 2016 Census






Figure 5 (continued) Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Top Twelve Ancestries, Total Responses, by Local Government Areas: 2016 Census






Figure 6 Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Persons Speaking Top Twelve Languages other than English by Local Government Areas: 2016 Census






Figure 6 (continued) Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Persons Speaking Top Twelve Languages other than English by Local Government Areas: 2016 Census






Figure 6 (continued) Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Persons Speaking Top Twelve Languages other than English by Local Government Areas: 2016 Census






Figure 6 (continued) Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Persons Speaking Top Twelve Languages other than English by Local Government Areas: 2016 Census






Figure 7 Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Top Twelve Religions by Local Government Areas: 2016 Census






Figure 7 (continued) Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Top Twelve Religions by **Local Government Areas: 2016 Census**






Figure 7 (continued) Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Top Twelve Religions by **Local Government Areas: 2016 Census**






Figure 7 (continued) Metropolitan Melbourne and Regional Victoria, Top Twelve Religions by **Local Government Areas: 2016 Census**




