

A Dingo Licence authorises the holder to possess, keep, breed, buy, sell and dispose of dingoes for non-commercial purposes and to possess dingoes at other sites for exercising, obedience training, education, or display at shows conducted by a canine association.

A Dingo Licence will only be issued to a natural person over 18 years of age.

Applications are subject to an on-site inspection of your dingo enclosure and may take up to 60 days.

Any licence issued that is based on false or misleading information is invalid and may lead to forfeiture of wildlife and prosecution. This form is not valid after 30 June 2022.

7. Collection, use and disclosure of personal information

The Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning (DELWP) is committed to protecting personal information provided by you in accordance with the principles of the Victorian privacy laws. A licence may not be issued if the information required is not provided.

8. Dingo enclosure requirements

Prior to applying for and/or acquiring any dingo, an enclosure must be completed. An inspection of the enclosure will be organised with you prior to a decision being made on your application. Dingo enclosures must:

- a. be child-proof and of sufficiently secure design and construction to prevent escape of dingoes and unauthorised access to dingoes.
- b. have a minimum floor area of 30 metres² for up to two dingoes and an additional 10 metres² for each additional dingo (over 9 months).
- c. have fences of either 3.0 metres in height or a minimum of 2.0 metres in height with an additional 45° degree inward return of at least 1.0 metre in length (or the inward return being a full secure roof).
- d. have a 1.0 metre inward-facing mesh return fitted at the base of the fence and fastened to the ground at right angles to the fence or the fence is anchored securely to a cement slab.
- e. have a secure escape-proof fence.

- 2. If your application is approved, a Payment Notice will be sent to you for payment within 30 days. If you have provided an email address in Part 4, your Payment Notice will only be emailed to the address specified.
- 3. When your payment is processed, your Wildlife Licence and *Protected Wildlife Record Book* will be sent to you via Australia Post. Electronic licences and Record Books are not available at this time.
- <u>Please note:</u> Please allow at least 2 weeks to receive your wildlife licence and Record Book after payment has been received. Incomplete or incorrect applications may delay approval of your application.
