This book is about a meeting we want to have with you.






The meeting will help us get to know you.




We will ask questions about you.




We use the answers to make your **profile**.

Profile means information about you.




The meeting will take about 1 hour and a half.

We can only have the meeting if your parents say **yes**.




You can choose to let us know what you think in the meeting.



How can you talk to us?



You can talk to us in the way you want.



• use your voice





- draw a picture
- show us photos



• play a video




• play a voice recording.



You can choose someone you trust to tell us about you.

For example, your mum.



If you come to the meeting you can choose to use our **communication cards**.

You can use the communication cards to tell us things like

- you do not understand a question
- you need a break
- you want to leave the meeting.

You can hold up or point to the card that you want to use.

The communication cards are on our website.

You can also ask someone to get the communication cards for you.







Who will see your answers?

We will keep your answers private.

Private means other people can only see your answers if

• your parents say **yes**

or

• the law says we must.

• focus on school work



• solve problems.





We want to know what support you need to do your work in class.


How do you do your school work?

We want to know what support you need to work alone.



For example

• you can work in a quiet place



• you can have a break.

You can tell us what you are good at.



You can tell us what you like to do.





We want to know what support you need to talk to others at school.

For example, do you use pictures?

How do you take care of yourself?

We want to know what support you need to take care of yourself at school.

For example, what support do you need to

• eat and drink



or

• go to the toilet.







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How do you get along with others?

We want to know what support you need to get along with other people.

For example, what support do you need to

• follow rules



or

• make friends.

How do you move?

We want to know what support you need to use your body.




For example, do you need anything to get around?




What happens after the meeting?

The report will also be about what other people said at the meeting.




Your school will get a copy of the report.
