### When to use this form

Use this form if you were unable to verify your identity online using the Service Victoria portal. This form should be submitted along with **certified copies** of identity documents as outlined.

# **Evidence of identity**

To finalise your application to Tobacco Licensing Victoria (TLV), you will need to verify your identity using:

- a satisfactory Commencement of Identity document
- a satisfactory Use in the Community document

If your name differs between these documents, you will also need to provide a Change of Name document. TLV may request further information or take additional steps to verify your identity if required.

### Accepted documents

You must provide **certified copies** of the following documents to verify your identity. Do not submit original documents to TLV.

**ONE** of the following Commencement of Identity documents:

- A full **Australian birth certificate** (not a birth extract or birth card) in your name or former name issued by a State or Territory registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages.
- An **Australian passport** in your name or former name which is current, or which has expired within the last three years.
- A foreign passport with a valid Australian visa in your name or former name.
- A current **ImmiCard** in your name issued by the Commonwealth Department of Home Affairs.
- An **Australian citizenship certificate** in your name or former name.

**And ONE** of the following Use in the Community documents:

- An Australian driver licence or learner permit
- A Medicare card.
- An **Australian passport** in your name or former name which is current, or which has expired within the last three years. Note this document cannot be used to verify use in community if already used as a Commencement of Identity document.

At least one of the documents provided must include a photo.

#### Change of name

If the Commencement of Identity document provided does not contain your current name, you must provide a Change of Name document.

Accepted Change of Name documents are:

• a **marriage certificate** issued by a State or Territory registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages,

or

• a **change of name certificate** issued by a State or Territory registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages

# Obtaining certified copies of identity documents

A 'certified copy' is a document that has been verified as a true and correct copy of the original by <u>someone with the legal authority</u> to do this.

The certifier needs to see both the original document and the copy at the same time. They will examine the copy, then stamp and sign it.

#### How to certify a document

1. Make a clear copy of your original document/s:

- If you don't have a photocopier or scanner, visit a print shop or your local library.
- The copy can be in black and white.
- 2. Take the original document/s and the copy to a person authorised to certify copies.
  - A full list of people who are authorised is available at justice.vic.gov.au/certifiedcopies
- 3. The certifier must certify that each copy of an original document is true and correct, by:
  - physically sighting the original document and the copies of the front and back at the same time
  - stamping (if available), signing and annotating the copy of the document with wording similar to 'I have sighted the original document and certify this to be a true and correct copy of the original document sighted'.



- providing the following details:
  - full name
  - telephone number
  - qualification
  - registration number (if relevant)
  - date of certification.
- If the original document is more than one page long, the certifier must:
  - initial or sign the bottom of each page of the copy (front and back)
  - number each page if the pages are not numbered.

# Providing documents from outside of Australia

If you live outside Australia or do not have the required Commencement of Identity and/or Use in the Community Documents, you must provide certified copies of equivalent foreign documents.

To certify documents outside Australia, take a copy and the original document to:

- 1. An Australian consulate or embassy official
- 2. A Notary Public
- 3. A local member of the police.

#### Documents in other languages

Copies of documents in a language other than English must also include an English translation of the document by an accredited translator and a statement from the translator indicating that it is a true and accurate translation of the original document.

The statement must also include the translator's full name and official stamp or seal or translator's identification number.

#### Translating documents in Australia

#### Translating documents overseas

Check with the translation service that they are approved to translate official documents for use in Australia before they translate your documents.
