

Major Transport Projects Facilitation Act 2009
PREMIER'S GUIDELINES MADE UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE
MAJOR TRANSPORT PROJECTS FACILITATION ACT 2009

Background

The Guidelines are made under section 13 of the **Major Transport Projects Facilitation Act 2009** ('the Act').

The Guidelines assist the Premier in deciding whether to declare a transport project, or a program of works or projects to be a 'declared project' under the Act.

Guidelines

The Premier, in deciding that a transport project or a program of works or projects is a 'declared project' to which the **Major Transport Projects Facilitation Act 2009** applies, must have regard to whether the transport project or the program of works or projects is of economic, social or environmental significance to the State or a region of the State.

The Premier may also have regard to the following considerations in making their decision:

1. the transport project or the program of works or projects involves the delivery of transport infrastructure that has been identified as a priority for a region, the State or a national network; and
2. the transport project or the program of works or projects would make a significant contribution to the State's:
 - a. strategic transport and land use objectives; or
 - b. transport policies and plans; and
3. the transport project or the program of works or projects involves a considerable level of capital investment and/or is of a significant size and complexity (i.e. involves a number of jurisdictions, project approvals or land assembly arrangements) such that it would benefit from the approvals process and delivery powers under the Act; and
4. any other matter the Premier considers relevant.
